have a great supply of plumbing and paint items as well. Come by and see them at 605 N. Main Street in Noble.

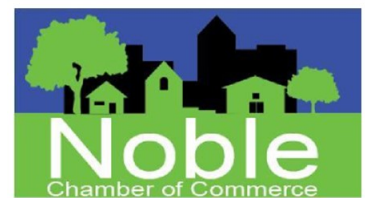

## Citywide Clean Up

Mark your calendars April 16-19th for the citywide cleanup! The City of Noble will be providing “Bulky Waste” pick up to all who have regular trash service with the City of Noble. Trash will be picked up on **YOUR REGULAR TRASH DAY**. Just place your bulky waste on the curb next to your poly cart.

Items that are accepted are small quantities of bundled and tied

tree limbs that are no larger 3 feet and 25 lbs., leaves up to 3 bags, Do-it-yourself remodeling waste that is containerized, discarded small household appliances, furniture, and mattresses. Items that are **NOT ACCEPTED** are piles of



branches, trees or tree stumps, rock, dirt, concrete. No loose items, all items **MUST** be bagged. No construction debris, industrial or commercial waste of any kind, including chemicals, paint, motor oil, hazardous waste, flammables, corrosives, explosives, car and truck batteries or tires. Please sure to follow rules as this is a great service that the city offers to our residents.
